Minimum rates as set out in Schedule (A) are basic minimum scales and nothing in this Agreement shall prevent the Company from paying the Employees a rate higher than these minimum rates, but the Company will not be obligated to pay more than the minimum rates without bargaining with an individual Employee for a higher rate and reaching an agreement to pay that Employee a higher rate.

Weekly rates are based on sixty (60) guaranteed hours per week which is equivalent to seventy (70) "pay hours".
